Hollywood Casino at Kansas Speedway Poker Tournament House Rules

- Unless otherwise provided by specific tournament rules, these House Rules shall apply
 to all tournaments. In the event of a conflict between these House Rules and specific
 tournament rules, the tournament rules shall control
- Participants must be age 21 or older and be able to present a valid government or state issued ID upon request at time of registration.
- 3. Participants must have a Marquee Rewards account and be in good standing with Hollywood Casino at Kansas Speedway (HCKS). Individuals who are excluded from casino facilities, either through a government program or by their own request, are not eligible.
- 4. Participants must register in person on the day of the tournament.
 - Registration for all tournaments begins at 8:00am on the day of the tournament unless otherwise noted.
 - b. Registration for all tournaments will be limited by available tables and staffing.
 - c. Players may buy-in to tournaments with cash or value cheques.
 - d. Late registration and re-entry will be accepted until the end of the registration period (which is determined by that particular event's blind structure.) If no seat is available at the time of registration, players will be placed on a list of "alternates" and will be guaranteed a seat once available.
 - e. All players will receive a full starting stack at time of entry.
 - i. Alternates, re-entries, and late entries will be seated in the order of registration and will have their stack put into play once a seat is available.
 - f. Players may forfeit their current chip stack during the registration period and be eligible to re-enter the tournament. The chips of a forfeited stack will be removed from play.
 - Chip forfeiture is not permitted in tournaments designated as "Bounty Tournaments."
- 5. All winnings will be paid by value cheques.
- 6. Once the players are officially "in the money" players may make deals and alter Payout Table if all remaining players come to a unanimous agreement (this is known as a "chop"). If a "chop" arrangement is made, the tournament will end immediately and all prize money will be distributed as per the players' agreement.
 - a. Official finishing position will be determined by chip count at the time of chop.
- 7. Players who lose all of their tournament chips shall be considered no longer part of the tournament and must leave the tournament area.
- Starting location of button for all tables will be determined on one table by drawing high card.
 - a. Re-draw for button will take place prior to start of the final table.
- Tables will play "hand for hand" if multiple tables are in still in play and the next player eliminated would result in the remaining players being in the money. The clock will continue to run during hand-for-hand.
- 10. When 10 or fewer players remain, they will re-draw for seating position on the final table.
- 11. The tournament clock will not be paused, except when consolidating players to the final table OR at management's discretion; time taken for floor calls and balancing tables is included in blind levels.
- 12. For tournament payouts when multiple players are eliminated at the completion of a hand, the following rules will apply:
 - a. With one table remaining, if more than one player is eliminated at the completion of a hand, the awarding of prize money will be based on the players' stack size at the start of the hand. If two or more players are eliminated on the same hand at separate tables, they will split the prize payouts as evenly as possible regardless of their starting chip stacks on that hand.
 - b. When two or more tables remain, if two or more players are eliminated on the same hand at the same table, they will split the prize money as in rule 12a. If two or more are eliminated on separate tables, they will split the prize payouts as evenly as possible regardless of their starting chip stacks on that hand.
- Winners of all prizes are responsible for payment of all applicable state and federal taxes to the required agency.
- 14. Under all circumstances the decision of HCKS Poker Management is final.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Poker Tournaments will use the Poker Tournament Directors Association Rules to supplement all house and regulatory rules.

*Entry Fee and total Starting Chips listed includes optional "Dealer Appreciation Bonus." Bonus fee goes directly to tournament dealers' tokes. For starting chips w/o Dealer Appreciation Bonus please see Structure, listed above.

** Bounty Tournaments: Each player will be issued value cheque(s) in the amount of the designated Bounty amount. This(these) cheque(s) will be designated as the player's "Bounty" for the duration of the tournament. Players must have their Bounty clearly displayed on the table to remain active in the tournament; players that cannot produce their Bounty) will be disqualified from the tournament. Eliminated players must forfeit their Bounty to the player who eliminated them.

PROMOTIONS

\$35,000 Free Roll

To qualify, players must:

- A) Play a minimum of 150 hours of Live Play within the qualifying period of Oct 1 Dec 31, 2017.
- i. A Minimum of 15 of those hours must be on BBJ Eligible Hold'em Tables.
- ii Grave Shift Bonus: Players playing from 2a-10a will receive 2.0 hours of credit towards the Free Roll for every 1 hour played.
- B) Be in the top 25 on our Oct Dec 2017 Tournament Leader Board.
- i. Players earn 1 pt for every entry in our daily tournaments and earn additional bonus pts for cashing in events.
- ii. Players must play a minimum of 15 hours of Live Play on eligible Hold'em tables within the qualification period in addition to being in top 25...

High Hands

Minimum qualifying hand is a Full House and must use a minimum of one hole card. Current High Hand, qualification period, and prize amount will be displayed in room. Hand does not need to reach showdown. Winning player must be present at end of qualifying period to claim prize. (10 minute grace period) Pot must reach at least \$20 and the BBJ \$1 taken. All cash prizes will be awarded in value gaming cheques. Table stakes apply when adding prize money to stack. Collection of promotional prizes requires Marquee Rewards account and a valid government or state issued ID.
