Roulette is a game that is easy to learn and exciting to play. A Roulette wheel contains numbered slots 0, 00, and 1-36. The dealer spins a white ball around the edge of the wheel and the ball drops into one of the numbered slots. The object of the game is to successfully place a wager on the number that the ball will fall into.

GETTING STARTED

After the dealer spins the ball, bets may be placed until the dealer sweeps his/her hand over the layout ending all bets being placed for that spin.

WINNING AND LOSING

After the ball rests in the number, the dealer will mark that number on the layout and sweep all losing bets before paying the winning wagers.

BETS

Inside Bets — each number on the inside area is associated with one of the three colors: Red, Black, or Green. Players may place their chips in a variety of positions covering varying amounts of numbers.

- Straight Up: A wager is entirely inside a numbered ulletarea and pays 35 to 1.
- Split: A wager where chips are placed between two numbers and pays 17 to 1.
- Street: A wager on a combination of three different numbers in one row and pays 11 to 1.
- Corner: Placing chips on the corner of a number covers four different numbers and pays 8 to 1.
- First Five: A wager on a combination of five numbers consisting of 0, 00, 1, 2, and 3 and pays 6 to 1.
- Double Street: A wager on a combination of six different numbers, such numbers shall be contained within two consecutive rows, and pays 5 to 1.

Outside Bets — betting areas on the "outside" include wagering on a red or black number, an odd or even number, or numbers 1-18 and 19-36. Winning wagers on these bets are paid 1 to 1. Additional groups of numbers may be bet on the outside with payoffs of 2 to 1.
